- Should submit completed application with a typed, one-page double-spaced essay explaining how receipt of this scholarship will help you achieve your ministry related goals.
- Course of study should lead to credentialing by the Assemblies of God.
- Funding shall be considered for non-traditional programs (Global, Berean, Master's Commission).
- As funding is made available by the Board, disbursements will be made.
